



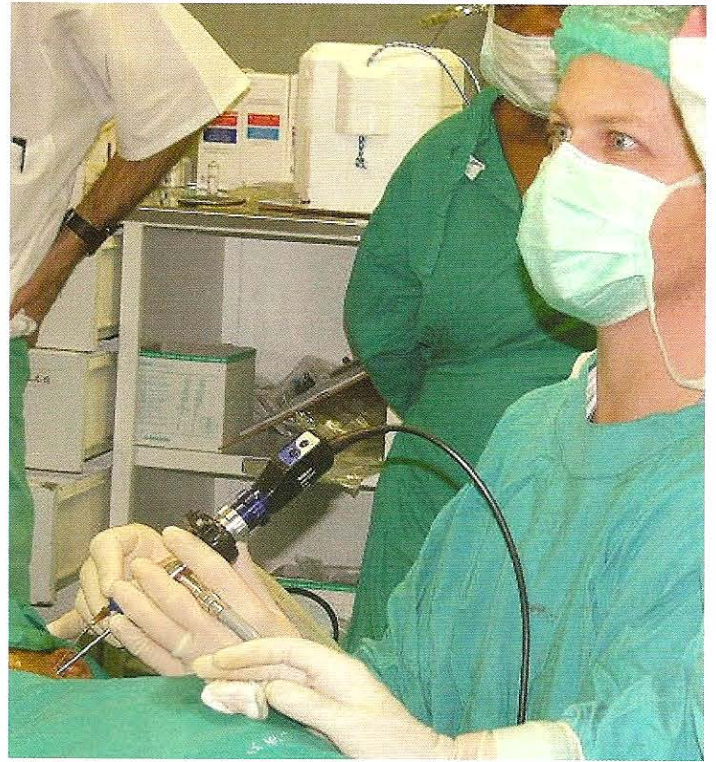

Staff of the University of Cape Town and other medical specialists perform the operations and a local hospital provides theatre facilities free of charge. This was the seventh year they offered their time and expertise.
